Minutes of the annual meeting held on Tuesday 18 May 2010 at 6.00 pm

Present:-

Councillor Gregory Szanto (Mayor) in the Chair

- 1. Former Councillors Michael Tunwell and Derek Townsend. The Mayor formally reported on the recent deaths of former Councillors Michael Tunwell and Derek Townsend. The Council stood for a minute's silence as a mark of respect.
- **2. Election of Mayor.** It was proposed by Councillor Madell and seconded by Councillor Goodwin:-

"That Carolyn Joan Heaps, a Councillor of this Borough be elected Mayor for the 2010/11 municipal year and until the election of Mayor at the next Annual Meeting of the Council."

It was accordingly:-

Resolved: (unanimously) That Carolyn Joan Heaps, a Councillor of this Borough be elected Mayor for the 2010/11 municipal year and until the election of Mayor at the next Annual Meeting of the Council.

Councillor Heaps then made the statutory declaration of acceptance of office as Mayor.

In her speech of acceptance, the Mayor reported that her nominated charities for the 2010/11 year would be Eastbourne YMCA and Eastbourne Young Carers (under the umbrella of 'Care for the Carers').

- **Minutes.** The minutes of the meeting held on 29 March 2010 were presented and the Mayor was authorised to sign them as a correct record.
- **4. Apologies for Absence.** Apologies for absence were reported from Councillors Belsey and Marsden.
- **5. Appointment of Deputy Mayor.** It was proposed by Councillor Tester and seconded by Councillor Purchese:-

"That Margaret Elizabeth Salsbury, a Councillor of this Borough be appointed Deputy Mayor for the 2010/11 municipal year and until the next Annual Meeting of the Council."

It was accordingly:-

Resolved: (Unanimously) That Margaret Elizabeth Salsbury, a Councillor of this Borough be appointed Deputy Mayor for the 2010/11 municipal year and until the next Annual Meeting of the Council.

Councillor Salsbury then made the statutory declaration of acceptance of office as Deputy Mayor and announced that her Deputy Mayor's Consort duties for the year would be shared between Ann McHale (her daughter), Benjamin Daly and Thomas Dock.

- **6. Investiture of Mayor's Consort.** The Mayor reported that Mr Mark Heaps would undertake the duty of Mayor's Consort for the 2010/11 municipal year.
- **7. Appointment of Mayor's Chaplain.** The Mayor reported that Mr Andrew Wilson, Pastor of Kings Church, Edison Road, Eastbourne, would be serving as the Mayor's Chaplain for the 2010/11 municipal year.
- 8. Vote of Thanks. It was proposed by Councillor Tutt, seconded by Councillor Elkin and agreed unanimously that a vote of thanks be extended to the outgoing Mayor and Mayoress, Councillor and Mrs Szanto. In his response, Councillor Szanto placed on record his appreciation for the support he had received from his mayoress, chaplain and Council officers. He also reported that his Mayor's charity raised over £22,000 for the Multiple Sclerosis Society in 2009/10.
- 9. Election of Leader of the Council and Chairman of the Cabinet. As a result of a proposal from Councillor Mattock, seconded by Councillor Stanley, it was:-

Resolved: (With no votes against) That Councillor David Tutt be elected Leader of the Council and Chairman of the Cabinet for the 2010/11 municipal year.

- **10. Executive Arrangements.** Councillor Tutt reported the following:
 - (a) That the names of those Councillors to serve on the Cabinet and the Councillor appointed as Deputy Leader of the Council (and Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet), be as shown on the schedule attached to these minutes for the 2010/11 municipal year. The only portfolio change from 2009/10 being that the new Cabinet member, Councillor Stanley would be taking over the Tourism and Leisure portfolio.
 - (b) That the terms of reference and constitution of the Cabinet be as set out in the Council's Constitution.
 - (c) That the delegation of executive functions to officers will continue to be as set out in the Scheme of Delegation to Officers, noting that relevant lead Cabinet members are to be consulted by officers when exercising their delegated powers where required to do so.

- (d) That delegations to individual Cabinet members in respect of executive functions have not been made at this time.
- 11. Establishment of Council Committees, Appointment of Chairmen, Deputy Chairmen and Members to serve on the Council Committees and appointment of Chairmen and Non-Executive Directors to Boards. The Council noted the report of the Local Democracy Manager on political balance and allocation of seats. As a result of this, together with consultation with Group Leaders, a proposed schedule of Chairmen, Deputy Chairmen and Members of Council Committees was circulated.

Following a proposal from Councillor Tutt, seconded by Councillor Elkin, it was:-

Resolved: (Unanimously) (1) That the proposed number and allocation of seats and nominations as set out on the schedules attached to these minutes be approved (with the exception of those bodies specified in recommendation (2) below).

- (2) That the proposed number and allocation of seats on advisory bodies and nominations as set out on the schedules attached to these minutes be approved.
- (3) That the existing independent members of the Standards Committee, Mr John Vesely (as Chairman), Mr Trevor Elliott and Mr Jaye Libeccio, be re-appointed for the 2010/11 Council year.
- (4) That the continuation of the following bodies be confirmed with terms of reference as set out in the Council's Constitution, and that they have a fixed membership to which members are appointed by the Chief Executive, Deputy Chief Executive or relevant Head of Service as the need arises:

13. Delegation of Non-Executive Functions. Following a proposal from Councillor Tutt, seconded by Councillor Elkin, it was:-

Resolved: (Unanimously) (1) That the delegation of non-executive functions, including terms of reference, to Committees, Sub-Committees, other Council bodies as set out in the relevant sections of the Council's Constitution be approved.

- (2) That the delegation of non-executive functions to Officers as set out in the Scheme of Delegation to Officers be approved.
- **14. Appointments to Outside Bodies.** Following a proposal from Councillor Tutt, seconded by Councillor Tester, it was:-

Resolved: (With no votes against) That the appointments of Members to serve on outside bodies be approved in accordance with the names listed on the schedule attached to these minutes.
