2.0	<u>Future Uses</u>

2.1	It may be advisable to conclude negotiations with potential occupiers prior to the next meeting of Cabinet. It is recommended, therefore, that authority to conduct these negotiations be delegated to the Chief Executive in consultation with the Leader of the Council and subsequently reported to Cabinet at the first available meeting.

3.1	This report adds a recommendation to report No. 20 and seeks delegated authority for resolution of the future use of the former Old Town library.
