LICENSING ACT 2003



The Licensing Act 2003 requires that Lewes District Council publish a Statement of Licensing Policy every three years. The current Licensing Policy was approved and came into effect on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2008.

In accordance with the Statutory Guidance issued by the Secretary of State under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003, the Council has to consult upon and prepare a Statement of Licensing Policy for a further 3 year period which will be in force with effect from 7<sup>th</sup> January 2011.

We have not received any local challenges to our existing Policy Statement or any adverse comment from the licensing trade, legal profession, other stake holders and the general public. Taking this into consideration, along with our experience over the past 3 years, we have decided that there will be no material changes to the Policy other than minor and consequential amendments relating to delegation of functions and addresses of responsible authorities.
