5. REPRESENTATIONS

It should be noted that one of the letter of objection's received, was on behalf of H. Ripley and Co, scrap metal recycling business.

The letter draws attention to the volume of vehicle (HGV) movements and noise associated with this business and the impact of this on the living conditions of proposed residential development. For example, it has been mentioned that, *"shipping takes place three times a month and on each occasion this requires an intensive period of delivery and ship loading during a continuous 72 hour (3 day) period (day and night)".* It is a busy commercial port location which can be subject to high levels of background noise.
