I object to this application for a number of reasons.

We have major problems with overflowing rubbish in the streets already. We have had bins sitting outside on the street with rubbish everywhere for over a week. This is another separate complaint which I will be escalating if nothing is done. This problem has been going on for years and we have been ignored. The seagulls rip open black bags on the street because the bins are full so people now just throw their rubbish into the street. We already have a major problem with cockroaches and rats due to the large amount of fast food establishments - too many! This is also a residential street.

The noise would also be a problem. Already it is an extremely noisy street and building. The noise insulation within the building is non-existent and my bedroom window is right next to the commercial property's extraction fan so this is already too much noise up until midnight. Giving out licenses without thought or care for residents - which seems to be the way of Eastbourne Council - is bad planning and encouraging an escalation in noise, fights, drunks and right across from my flat is a well-known drug pushing corner. The police drive past most nights and these local dealers are ignored. We should not have to live like this.

We also need to stop the dog problem.

There are too many commercial take out properties in that area and along Seaside road. This brings the unsocial and disruptive element to the area.

When will the council sit up and listen and make a change about the antisocial aspect of the area rather than encourage the bad behaviour, noise, drugs and rubbish? Enough is enough.

I strongly object to this application and will fight it all the way. These 'take out' owners have no right to encourage anti social behaviour and to impinge seriously upon lives of the residents.

If this license goes ahead I will escalate the complaint through social media and the press. I complained about this a couple of years ago and was ignored again by the council. I was told that Eastbourne will not give out too many licenses in one area. This has happened in Susans Rd and Seaside road. There is also an issue of being to walk on the pavement without obstructions. Every commercial property has now a free standing sign outside , on the pavement, which is dangerous and will not be long before there is an accident. Also the properties have put out tables and chairs in the street as if we're in the Mediterranean! Again, this creates more noise and antisocial behaviour along with adding more obstructions on the small pavements. This should not be permitted.
