## Minutes of the annual meeting held on Wednesday 25 May 2011 at 6.00 pm

Present:-

- 1. Election of Mayor.** It was proposed by Councillor Ungar and seconded by Councillor Coles:-

"That Carolyn Joan Heaps, a Councillor of this Borough be elected Mayor for the 2011/12 municipal year and until the election of Mayor at the next Annual Meeting of the Council."

It was accordingly:-

**Resolved:** (Unanimously) That Carolyn Joan Heaps, a Councillor of this Borough be elected Mayor for the 2011/12 municipal year and until the election of Mayor at the next Annual Meeting of the Council.

Councillor Heaps then made the statutory declaration of acceptance of office as Mayor.

In her speech of acceptance, the Mayor reported that her nominated charity for the 2011/12 year would be the Tuesday O'Hara Fund.

- 2. Honorary Freeman Maurice Skilton.** The Council observed a one minute silence in memory of Honorary Freeman Maurice Skilton, who died on Tuesday 17 May 2011.

Maurice Skilton was born in Eastbourne in 1920 and grew up in Royal Sussex Crescent in the Old Town. He served throughout the Second World War with local TA Regiment, Royal Artillery and was mentioned in dispatches whilst serving with the 8th Army in North Africa. He also worked as a bespoke tailor before his retirement.

He was first elected a councillor in 1961 for the former County Borough of Eastbourne and served until its abolition in 1974 (the last 10 years as an alderman). He was elected to the newly formed Borough Councillor in 1973 and served until 2006 with just one year break in that time. He was elected as Mayor in 1991/92 and again in 1992/93. He was Deputy Mayor in 1974/75 and again in 1990/91. He also served as Leader of the Council for the 4 years between 1984 and 1988.

Maurice Skilton was an East Sussex county councillor from 1974 to 1977 and from 1985 to 2009. He was Vice Chairman of the County Council in 1996/97 and Chairman in 1998/99 and 1999/2000. He was awarded the MBE in the 1998 New Year's Honours' List for services to the community in East Sussex.

Maurice Skilton, was honoured with the Freedom of the Borough of Eastbourne at a special ceremony at the Town Hall on 7 January 2008. The Honour was awarded to recognise the outstanding contribution that he had made to Eastbourne and its community for more than 45 years and serving as a councillor for the Old Town on both the Eastbourne Borough and East Sussex County Councils.

He had a lead role in significant developments and events such as Eastbourne Park, the Annual Horse Show, and the International Children's Conference, the latter in partnership with UNICEF and first held in 1995 in Eastbourne. He had also worked with many local voluntary and charitable groups including the Old Town Library, Beachy Head Countryside Centre and Open Door.

3. **Minutes.** The minutes of the meeting held on 20 April 2011 were presented and the Mayor was authorised to sign them as a correct record.
4. **Apologies for Absence.** An apology for absence was reported from Councillor Stanley.
5. **Appointment of Deputy Mayor.** It was proposed by Councillor Hearn and seconded by Councillor Murray:-

"That Michael John Thompson, a Councillor of this Borough be appointed Deputy Mayor for the 2011/12 municipal year and until the next Annual Meeting of the Council."

It was accordingly:-

**Resolved:** (Unanimously) That Michael John Thompson, a Councillor of this Borough be appointed Deputy Mayor for the 2011/12 municipal year and until the next Annual Meeting of the Council.

Councillor Thompson then made the statutory declaration of acceptance of office as Deputy Mayor and announced that his Deputy Mayoress for the year would be his wife, Linda Thompson with his daughter, Joanne Scott, standing in when necessary.

On behalf of the Council, the Mayor proposed a vote of thanks to Margaret Salsbury for her contribution as Deputy Mayor during the 2010/11 municipal year. Margaret Salsbury thanked her consorts, Tom Dock, Ben Daly and Ann McHale for their support during her deputy mayoral year.

6. **Investiture of Mayor's Consort.** The Mayor reported that Mr Mark

Heaps would undertake the duty of Mayor's Consort for the 2011/12 municipal year but she would continue to take the opportunity to offer youngsters the opportunity to accompany her on some engagements.

- 7. Appointment of Mayor's Chaplain.** The Mayor reported that Mr Martyn Relf, Elder of the Living Stones Community Church, Ocklynge Road, Eastbourne would be serving as the Mayor's Chaplain for the 2011/12 municipal year.
- 8. Borough Council Elections held on 5 May 2011.** The Council received the report of the Returning Officer on the outcomes of the recent Borough Council Elections. It was proposed by Councillor Tutt, seconded by Councillor Elkin and;

**Resolved:** (Unanimously) (1) That the report of the Returning Officer be noted and that the Returning Officer and his staff be thanked for their efforts in conducting the elections.

- 9. Election of Leader of the Council and Chairman of the Cabinet.** As a result of a proposal from Councillor Mattock, seconded by Councillor Harris,
