

It is fair to say that we have ow fair share of inscruptions drivers who overcharge the public via the extra buffor on the meter, charging for shopping bags etc is common pratice for those drivers which in turn gives us all a bad name, with this new Proposed Tariff the maximum for extrois has been raised to \$3.00 from \$2.00 giveing scope for those drivers to overcharge even more.

Extrais should be scrapped once and for all, it is a nonsence to charge for extra People and buggage, more to the point no one has never come up with any post that it cost more to run your car with extra People or buggage on board.
