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#### **Purpose of Report:**

To report the sickness statistics from 1 April 2013 until 30 September 2013 and the Safety Forum's comments on them.

#### **Reasons for Recommendations**

1 The Forum discussed the sickness statistics and asked that a commentary provided to Employment Committee.

#### Information

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- 2.1 Looking at the sickness statistics for the first half of the year 2013 to 2014, there have been a total of 2,279 days taken off as a result of sickness and disorders.
- 2.2 Of these, 789 (34%) were for musculo-skeletal and back/spinal disorders (mostly in District Services and Housing Services) and 482 (21%) were for stress (again mostly in District and Housing Services).
- 2.3 Operations and recovery from them accounted for the next highest number of days off at 156 (7%), and colds (93 days 4%) and viral

infections (86 days - 4%) were the other significant amounts of time taken off work due to sickness.
