1	Election of Chair of the Sub-Committee <u>Resolved:</u> 1.1 That Councillor Adeniji be elected Chair of the Sub-Committee for the duration of the meeting.	
2	Exclusion of the Public and Press <u>Resolved:</u> 2.1 That, under Section 100(A)(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended), the public and press be excluded from the hearing applications as set out in Report No 73/17 as there was likely to be disclosures of exempt information as defined in paragraph 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Act. The public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.	

3 Application for a Personal Licence

The Sub-Committee considered Report No 166/17 relating to an application for a personal licence.

The Licensing Officer presented the Report to the Sub-Committee. She drew the Sub-Committee's attention to the salient points of the Report, including background information about the Applicant and the circumstances that had led up to the hearing.

The Licensing Officer advised the Sub-Committee of the options available in making a determination in respect of the Report, namely;

- Reject the application if the Sub-Committee considers it appropriate for the promotion of the crime prevention objective; or
- Grant the application.

The Sub-Committee took into account the additional written documents of representation submitted by the Applicant.

The Sub-Committee withdrew to determine the matter at 11:45am. The decision was made as follows:

- 3.1 That the Application for a Personal Licence, as referred to in Report No 166/17, be refused.
