Lewes Town Council – Members received a letter from the Priory Trust objecting to the proposed change of use, especially the loss of a valued amenity in an area where improvements to the adjacent Priory grounds and open space are planned for the near future and a growth in tourism is anticipated. Members concurred with the objections stated by the Priory Trust and objected strongly to the change of use as this will lead to the permanent loss of a valuable public amenity at this location.

Three additional letters from local residents, objecting to the loss of the toilets as it already forces people to urinate in the adjacent hedges, lack of facilities for those who use the sports pitches nearby, loss of privacy, increased noise nuisance.
