Planning Applications OUTSIDE the South Downs National Park

179 LW/16/0542 – Former School Site, Western Road, Newhaven, East Sussex BN9 9ED

Councillors Dr Keith Corbett and June Dyer spoke on behalf of Newhaven Town Council. Mrs C Temple spoke against the proposal.

Resolved:

179.1 That planning application LW/16/0542 for the redevelopment to provide 31 houses (25 open market houses and 6 affordable houses) be refused.

Reasons for decision:

I. The proposed development would, by reason of the scale, number and siting of the new dwellings, have a cramped and over-developed appearance that is discordant and incongruous with the spatial characteristics and layout of existing housing within the locality. As such the proposals would be detrimental to visual amenity and the character of the local area, contrary to retained policy ST3 and Core

- Policy 11 of the Lewes District Local Plan Part One: Joint Core Strategy and National Planning Guidance contained in the National Planning Policy Framework 2012; and
- II. The proposed development would, by reason of the siting and landscaping to the new homes, result in the loss of a significant number of protected trees (Tree Preservation Order No. 6 of 2003), including an historic Huntingdon Elm, thereby eroding the character and appearance of the locality to the detriment of visual amenity and contrary to retained policy ST3 and Core Policy 11 of the Lewes District Local Plan Part One: Joint Core Strategy and National Planning Guidance contained in the National Planning Policy Framework 2012.
