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SDNP/17/06183/HOUS – Page 38 Plumpton

Delete condition 3 and replace with:

"Before the development hereby approved is commenced on site, details/samples of all external materials shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority and carried out in accordance with that consent.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory development in keeping with the locality having regard to Policy ST3; of the Lewes District Local Plan and to comply with National Policy Guidance contained in the National Planning Policy Framework 2012."

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## SDNP/17/05923/FUL – Page 47 Ditchling

Three additional letters of objection:

- The proposed house would have an overbearing impact on its surroundings and on no. 10 Beacon Road.
- The proposed house would have an inappropriate appearance for the traditional character of the village.
- The considerable increase in glazing proposed would also result in harm to the quality of dark night skies.
- Currently no overlooking to the rear or side garden of no.10 Beacon Road, proposed house will introduce substantial areas of glazing at first floor which will overlook no. 10.
- The proposed house would have a detrimental impact on the setting of the conservation area as a consequence of its height, mass, materials and glazing. No assessment of the impact on any heritage assets has been submitted with the application.
- Minor changes to the scheme do not overcome our objections albeit the obscure glazing to the study window is welcomed (this should be conditioned).

- Soft white render is inadequate to reduce the overall dominance of the dwelling in the landscape.
- Officers meeting with applicants/agent rings alarm bells.
- Amendments are trivial.
- Decision should be withheld until Councillors have had the opportunity to conduct a site visit.
