A small amendment to the drawings has been received to improve light levels to a ground floor residential unit fronting North Street, through the incorporation of an additional window on the North Street elevation. The applicant has confirmed the position outlined by the submitted Financial Viability Assessment (FVA), which demonstrates that the scheme would not be viable should financial contributions be sought.

This discussion is ongoing, but the position outlined by the FVA is supported by Officers and the Council's elected viability consultants, in the interest of delivering the scheme.

Members will note the recommendation to seek delegated authority to obtain agreement on the servicing arrangements with ESCC Highways and this opportunity would be used to conclude the discussion with regard to any captured contributions, together with other highways matters, including the legal position surrounding removal of parking permits.
