Most of our Councillor and Committee web pages and documents are managed through the Civica Modern.Gov platform.

How accessible are the committee webpages?

We know that some parts of our Councillor and Committee web pages are not fully accessible:

- Some of our older PDF documents are not fully accessible to screen reader software. In addition, some are generated from software or provided from outside the Council which may not be fully accessible.
- Some of our documents are required to be published on a statutory date, so cannot be altered after that date.
- In future, we may include YouTube player and Twitter feeds that can cause accessibility issues.
- Live video streams do not always have captions available.
- A page may contain elements automatically generated from content held outside of the website (in Minutes, Agendas and Decisions). It is not always possible to ensure such content meets all the new accessibility requirements.
- Our pages do not have skip navigation on them as the top navigation content is small and the main content is reached quickly.
- Some of our article section names are not linked to their ID title.

Our committee webpages are checked by [SiteImprove](#) for Level A, AA and AAA standards of the WCAG 2.1. The Democratic Services Team continue to monitor issues that arise using their live report for our pages. We aim to fix them as soon as we are able to.
