With reference to the above license variation request dated 4th May 2024 by Omi Leisure Ltd.

Once again, we as local residence we are subjected to jet another variation request, on this occasion, to extend the hours to 03.00 for playing of loud music.

Hopefully you are aware that we have numerous complaints lodged with Mr Temitayo Olatunji (Environmental Protection & Private Sector Housing) regarding loud music being played daily into the early hours by the bars in Bolton road.

The problem is that the Noise team only patrol up until 23.00 hrs and the owners are well aware of this fact and hence tend to crank up the volume after this time.

Of late one of the bars seem to be playing loud music from the back of the premises rather than onto Bolton road (Front). This goes on until 02.00 hrs. As the back area architecture of the surrounding buildings tends to drastically amplify the music thus affecting residencies on this side of Lismore road.

As residence we have a right to a peaceful and undisturbed night, as the current situation is still unsatisfactory and unresolved we clearly strongly object to this variation request.
