FOUND UNDER ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

1. REMOVE THE CONDITION/OBJECTIVE TO SUPPLY AND SERVE FOOD/LATE NIGHT REFRESHMENT.

THIS CONDITION COULD BE REMOVED AS IT IS NOT IN THE BUSINESS/COMPANYS' OBJECTIVES TO SERVE FOOD AT THE PRESENT TIME. THE MAJORITY OF THE CONDITIONS ON THE LICENCE TEND TO BE INFLUENCED BY THE PROSPECT OF SERVING/SUPPLYING FOOD HOWEVER THAT IS NOT THE INTENTION. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE REMOVAL OF THIS CONDITION/OBJECTIVE/SCHEDULE WOULD POSITIVELY INFLUENCE THE BUSINESS AND PROMOTE BETTER BUSINESS WITH THE EASTBOURNE TOWN AREA PLUS PROVIDE THE PREMISES WITH THE ATMOSPHERE THAT IS SOUGHT.

PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

2. 'WITHIN THE OUTSIDE GARDEN AREA - 'CAFE/BAR' CONDITIONS SHALL APPLY SUCH THAT SERVICE IN THE GARDEN SHALL BE BY WAITER/WAITRESS SERVICE TO PERSONS THAT ARE SEATED.

THE REASON THIS CONDITION SHOULD BE REMOVED IS THAT PLANNING PERMISSION HAS BEEN ACCEPTED TO COMPLETLY RENOVATE AND MODIFY THE GARDEN AREA. IT WILL BE THE MAIN SEATING AREA IN THE PREMISES. IT IS AND WILL BE MUCH MORE SUFFICIENT TO ALLOW REGULAR CUSTOMER-TO-BAR SERVICE IN THE GARDEN AREA. AS MENTIONED ABOVE HOPEFULLY SAID OBJECTIVE TO SERVE/SUPPLY FOOD WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE LICENCE SO THIS WILL INFLUENCE THE REMOVAL OF THE CONDITION BEING DESCRIBED IN (2.)

3.SEATING AS CURPENTLY PROVIDED IN THE INTERNAL BAR AREAS SHALL REMAIN, COMPRISING 22 TABLE SEATS PLUS BAR STALLS ON THE LOWER LEVEL AND 28 TABLE SEATS PLUS BAR STALLS ON THE UPPER LEVEL.

THE REMOVAL OF THIS CONDITION WILL PROVIDE FURTHER SPACE FOR THE CLIENTEL OF BOLTONS TO ENJOY THEIR EVENING AND THE ENTERTAINMENT/MUSIC THAT IS PROVIDED. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THIS WILL PROVIDE A SAFER ENVIRONMENT WIHTIN THE PREMISES IN REGARDS TO FIRE AND SAFETY AND HELP PREVENT CRIME AND DISORDER AS OBJECTS SUCH A MULTIPLE TABLES AND CHAIRS WILL BE REMOVED.

IT IS SUGGESTED THAT A MAXIMUM OF 12 STALLS WITH RELEVANT TABLES BE PROVIDED ON THE LOWER LEVEL AND A MAXIMUM OF 20-22 TABLE SEATS IN THE FORM OF BOOTHS AND MAXIMUM 8 STALLS BE PROVIDED ON THE UPPER LEVEL. THIS IS ALSO TO PROMOTE GOOD BUSINESS PRACTICE AND AN ENJOYABLE ATMOSPHERE. THE APPORVED PLANS FOR THE GARDEN AREA RENOVATION ALSO INCLUDE AN ADDITIONAL FIRE EXIT WHICH IS APPORVED BY FIRE AND RESCUE AND THE MAIN SEATING AREA AS MENTIONED IN (2.) WILL BE WITHIN THE GARDEN AREA. ON AN ADDITIONAL NOTE IN RESPECT TO FIRE AND RESCUE, IF THERE WERE A FIRE THE MAIN SEATING AREA (GARDEN) THE RELEVANT FIRE EXITS WOULD BE THE NEW FIRE EXIT WITHIN THE GARDEN AND THROUGH THE LOWER LEVEL GARDEN ACCESS DOORS INTO THE MAIN BAR PREMISES. THEREFORE THE AMOUNT OF CHAIRS AT CURRENT ON THE LICENSING CONDITIONS WOULD PROVE A FIRE RISK, THIS WILL INFLUENCE THE REMOVAL AND THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE SUGGESTED AMOUNT OF SEATING.

4. ALL SUPERVISORS/STAFF SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK

THIS CONDITION IS NOT NEEDED WITHIN THE LICENCE. CHILDREN ARE NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE PREMISES AND STAFF. ARE TRAINED IN ALCOHOL, LICENCING OBJECTIVES, HEALTH AND SAFETY, FIRE AND SAFETY AND ALL RELEVANT AREAS.

UNDER PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

5. DOUBLE GLAZING FITTED

THIS CONDITION CAN BE REMOVED AS ALL NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS AND PROCEDURES HAVE BEEN PUT IN PLACE AND ARE OPERATING TO REDUCE PUBLIC NUISANCE. In terms of specific regulated entertainments please note that:

- Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
