

APPENDIX 3: Breakdown of Representations by Policy

The Lewes Local Plan Part 2 was subject to a six week consultation between 24th September and 5th November 2018. During this time, a total of 701 representations were made on the plan from 496 representors.

The majority of the 496 representors were individuals, but they also included: eight town/parish councils; three neighbouring authorities; and 10 other statutory consultees, including the Environment Agency, Natural England, Historic England and East Sussex County Council.

A total of 611 representations were made on specific policies within the plan. Representations were made on 37 of the 49 policies. However, the response to the consultation was dominated by two main issues:

Policy E1: Land at East Quay Newhaven Port received the highest number of representations with 241 submitted. This is closely followed by *Policy GT01: Land south of the Plough* with 218 submitted.

For context, the next most commented on policy was *Policy BA01: Land at Hillside Nurseries, High Street* with 14 representations.

There were 13 policies that didn't attract any representations: *Policies DM3, DM5, DM7, DM12, DM13, DM20, DM21, DM23, DM26, DM28, DM29, DM34, and DM37.*

There were 90 representations made on parts of the plan not specifically relating to policies. This includes six representations on the Habitats Regulations Assessment, four representations on the Sustainability Appraisal and three representations relating to the Duty to Co-operate.

There were also 17 representations relating to the number of homes planned. In addition, there were 11 representations relating to the omission of development sites within the plan.

47 representors expressed a wish to participate at the oral examination of the plan.
